We are currently recruiting candidates for an Environmental Technician position. The candidate will be responsible for performing soil sampling, water sampling, and contractor oversight at large cleanup sites. Other assignments may include Phase I ESA preparation, report preparation, database management, and other general environmental staff services as applicable and based on experience.

The position will be available in late March, 2010.

This position requires a versatile quick learner to be proficient in several areas of environmental sampling and analysis. This position will include significant potential for learning many skills and provides great opportunity for advancement. The ideal candidate will possess a background in Geology, Engineering, Biology, Chemistry, or Environmental Science.

An Environmental Technician should be able to work on their own in the field and report back to senior staff, take comprehensive and legible field notes; communicate well with the office and when interacting with clients and site contractors; solve problems in the field under the guidance of the responsible professional, be willing to work flexible hours; be willing to travel; and maintain a professional attitude in the field and the office.

Requirements

Candidate must be proficient with Microsoft Word, Excel, and Internet; analytical and problem solving ability; demonstrated written and verbal communications skills; demonstrated ability to effectively coordinate projects; ability to interpret maps; and must be able to interact with a team including: clients, engineers, and contractors. A valid driver's license is required.

Candidate's responsibilities will include, but not be limited to:

- 1) Performing oversight of a construction contractor at a cleanup site involving removal/disposal of contaminated soil.
- 2) Performing water quality monitoring from a 15-ft long sampling boat in Commencement Bay, Washington. You will be one member of a two-person crew.
- 3) Performing soil, sediment, groundwater, and storm water sampling.
- 4) Organizing and prioritizing a diverse workload; maintaining accurate records; ability to work effectively with minimal supervision in a small office environment.
- 5) Performing environmental, health and safety services requiring the exercising of sound judgment.
- 6) Equipment tracking and upkeep, and accurate recording of field data.
- 7) Assisting a senior staff person with report preparation.
